Infrastructure Development Projects

1. South Railway Run

Rehabilitation of the 51-kilometer railway line from Calamba City, Laguna to Batangas City, into a modern, convenient, and fast rail transport system for passengers and cargoes.

2. CALABARZON International Airport & Free Trade Zone

Conversion of the Fernando Air Base (FAB) in Lipa City, into a dual use airport serving the Southern Tagalog Region (STAR), and subsidiary airport to the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) in Manila, and the development of a 1,500-hectare area contiguous to the FAB into a dynamic zone through private sector initiative.

3. Batangas Port Development Project Phases III & IV

Land acquisition, development, management and operation of the Batangas Port Development Project Phases III & IV into an Export Processing and Free Trade Zone.

The BPDP Phase III and Phase IV have a total area of approximately 30 hectares and 100 hectares, respectively.

4. Rehabilitation And Expansion Of Subukin Port

The objective of this project is to maximize the utilization of the existing port facilities located in Brgy. Subukin, San Juan Batangas that will surely aid in economic advancement and spur enhanced business activities in the area. The project will entail rehabilitation and improvement of the port facilities.

5. Batangas Port Livelihood Center

Rehabilitation, management and operation of the Batangas Port Livelihood Center (BPLC), a 3-storey commercial building with roof deck located at the Phase I of the Batangas Port in Sta. Clara, Batangas City. BPLC has a total floor area of 19,028 square meters, more or less, built on a 2-hectare property leased to the Provincial Government of Batangas until 2028.

6. Regional Food Terminal

Development, management and operation of the 29-hectare government property located along the Batangas Bay in Barangay Sta. Rita Aplaya, Batangas City, into a Food Terminal Complex in line with the Regional Agro-Industrial Modernization of the CALABARZON Region.
